The Project

The [Mountain Recreation Strategic Action Plan](#) is the third inter-related study conducted since 2011 to help determine and prioritize the needs, desires and priorities for park, recreation and trail facilities/programs in Park City and the Snyderville Basin Special Recreation District. With future population expected to grow by 47,000 people over the upcoming 10-year planning horizon, this plan will serve a vital role in helping to organize and prioritize shorter-term recreation initiatives and resources, and to help ensure that services are not unduly replicated between Park City and the Basin.

Purpose of the Meeting

Results of the [Recreation Facility Demand Study \(2011\)](#) inventories parks and recreation facilities by location and by agency ownership. The [Community Interest and Opinion Survey \(2012\)](#) set the foundation to better understand demographics and constituent desires as part of the prioritization of recreation facilities that are needed. Park City and the Snyderville Basin Special Recreation District now desire to strategically plan the implementation of future facilities. With the assistance of Landmark Design, a planning and design firm located in Salt Lake City, these previous studies have now been reviewed; existing facilities analyzed; open space, trails, and land use patterns assessed; and the capacity of existing facilities and sites investigated.

The purpose of this meeting is to get public input on the work that has been completed to date. This is your opportunity to review the analysis and ideas that have taken place so far, and to provide guidance and input into the direction of the Strategic Action Plan before it is finalized.
